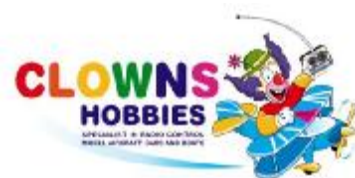

On 16 December our team consisting of Martin Knoetzen, Keith Evershed and Dudley Evershed tackled the sixth running of the West Coast Long run.

Using a 60 size Joss stick powered by an old OS91 four stroke fuelled with 1,5 litres of fuel we tackled the route once again. This year the weather was favourable in terms of wind but was overcast with drizzle for most of the morning.

There were 8 competitors using aircraft of all shapes and sizes. The smallest plane was an electric powered model with an auto pilot system. The wing span being around 1 meter. The largest model, an Ugly Stick of about 3m wing span powered by a 50cc petrol engine.

We took off at the entrance to Silverstroom Strand resort and flew along the R27 to Veldrift. The end point being the local sports fields in the town. The distance being about 100km.

Of the 8 teams that took off 5 made it to the end. We made it in a time of 1 hour and 2 mins from take off to touch-down.
